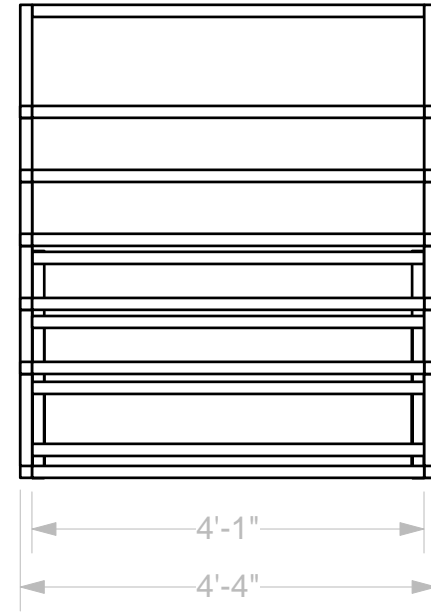


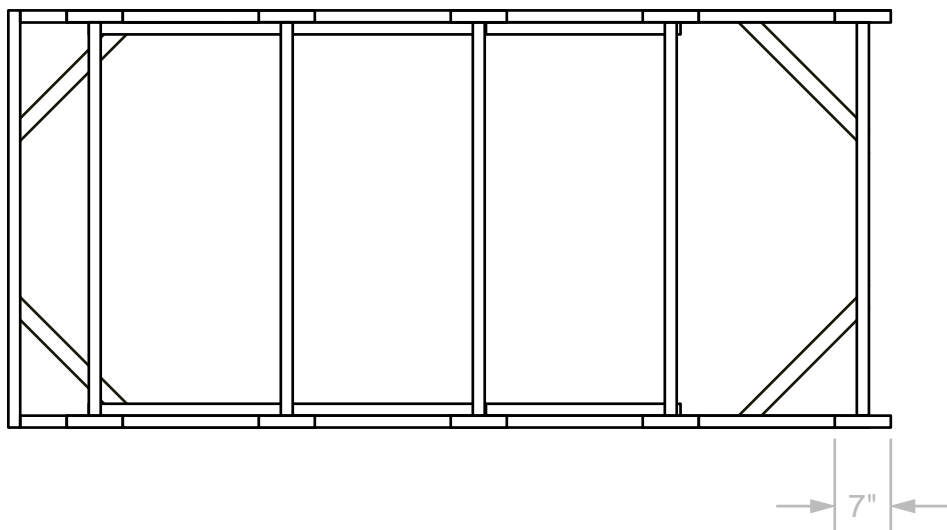
Top View



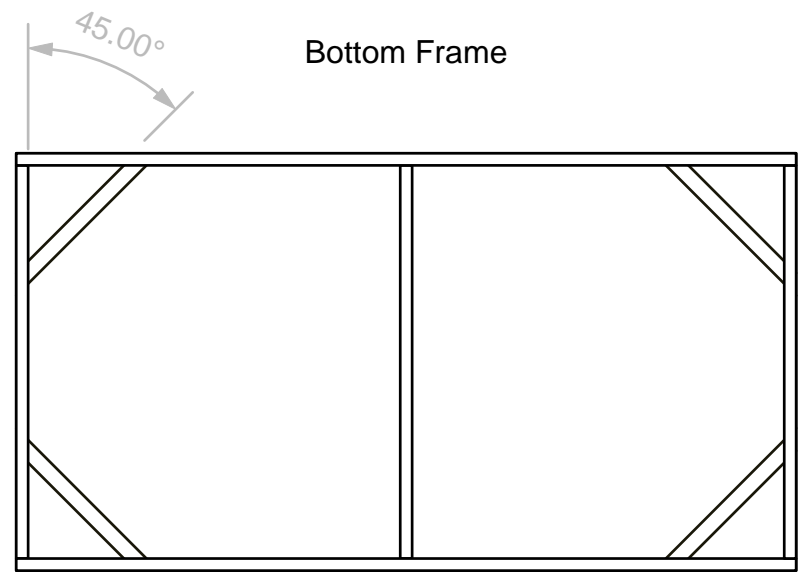
Front View

Notes-

1) To ensure square, set up a jig on a sheet of ply. Since the overall width of each section is 4'-4", just rotate the frame to fit the jig. You may use two sheets of ply if necessary.

2) I will supply you with the casters we will use. They will be centered on the 8 bottom diagonals and attached with U-bolts.

3) The side diagonals will be attached to the frame using the hex head bolts.

4) A separate drafting will be given with the size/position of 2x10s along with their attachment method.
